Verizon Wireless Mobile Broadband already gives you on-the-go access to high-speed Internet on America's largest and most reliable 3G network. Now you have more ways to access the Internet on the go. Connect to thousands of Verizon Wi-Fi hotspots with your monthly Mobile Broadband or GlobalAccess plan at no additional cost. That means more browsing, more downloading, and more email—more of everything you use the Web for, including connecting to company networks.

Verizon Wi-Fi is available in airports, bookstores, cafes, restaurants, hotels, and other locations across the country. Verizon Wi-Fi works in Canada and Mexico, too, so you can avoid roaming charges when connected to a Verizon Wi-Fi hotspot available with your monthly Mobile Broadband or GlobalAccess plan.

How it works.

When you're in range of a Verizon Wi-Fi hotspot, you can connect to it with VZAccess Manager from your Wi-Fi-enabled PC. Stay on Wi-Fi as long as you like and then jump right back on the high-speed Mobile Broadband network when you're on the move. You can manage your monthly Mobile Broadband data allowance on your terms. It's up to you.

Here's what you'll need to start using Verizon Wi-Fi.

- A monthly Mobile Broadband or GlobalAccess plan
- A Mobile Broadband USB modem, PC Card, ExpressCard,[®] Verizon Wireless MiFi™ 2200 Intelligent Mobile Hotspot,¹ or a notebook/netbook with Mobile Broadband Built-In
- A Wi-Fi-enabled notebook or netbook running Windows[®] 7, Windows Vista,[®] XP, or 2000²
- VZAccess Manager version 7.2 or higher

¹ MiFi 2200 Intelligent Mobile Hotspot must be connected to a PC via USB cable to access the Internet in Verizon Wi-Fi hotspot locations. When in USB mode, Wi-Fi capability on the MiFi is disabled. Only one PC at a time can access the Internet from a Verizon Wi-Fi hotspot when in USB mode.

² Verizon Wi-Fi not available on notebooks running Mac[®] OS.

Customers with Prepaid Mobile Broadband Plans or Mobile Broadband Connect features are not eligible for Verizon Wi-Fi.

Verizon Wi-Fi hotspots are not owned or operated by Verizon Wireless. Verizon Wireless is not able to estimate upload or download speeds at these locations. Customers are responsible for providing security measures for their computers and data. Many Wi-Fi hotspots are not secure. Customers should connect to the Mobile Broadband network when more security is needed.

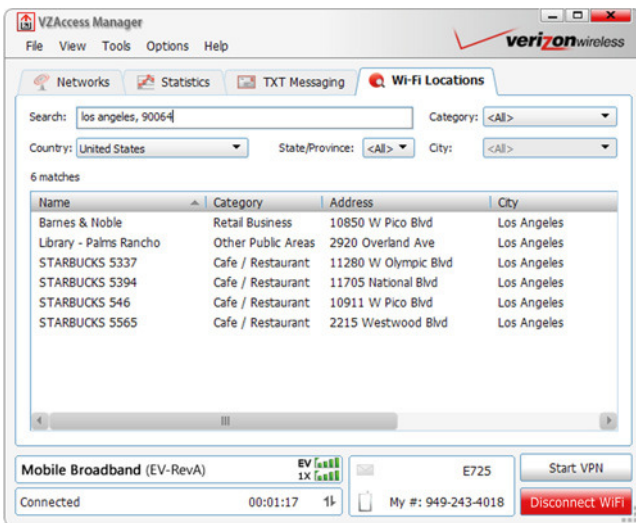
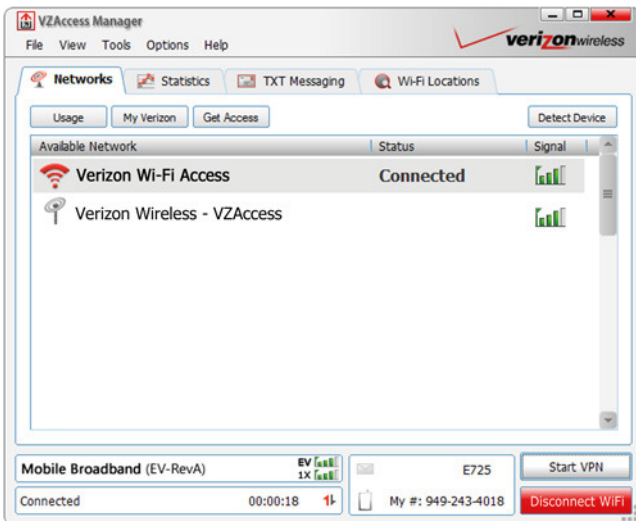

STEPS TO CONNECT TO VERIZON WI-FI.

Here's how to connect to Verizon Wi-Fi using the latest version of VZAccess Manager³ on your Mobile Broadband-capable device:

- Open VZAccess Manager.
- Insert your Mobile Broadband device or power on your Mobile Broadband Built-In module.
- Enable Wi-Fi on your PC or attach a Wi-Fi adapter (sold separately).
- In VZAccess Manager, select **Verizon Wi-Fi Access** under **Available Network**.
- Click **Connect Wi-Fi**.
- Launch your Web browser, email application, or other Internet application.
